Giza David was born and raised in Germany where she was inspired in both her vocation as an acupuncturist and in artistic pursuits by her father, a doctor, who also painted watercolors and did pencil drawings, some of which were used as illustrations in a local newspaper.

When Giza was 32, she came to the U.S. and settled in Spokane, WA. Although she has received no formal art training, she has mastered a number of media including watercolor, pastels, oil, and acrylic. “Art is a kind of meditation for me,” David observes. “It is a real treat, and so much fun. I never want it to be a job. A job is something you work at, but art is the opposite of work for me.”

Gisa’s works are realistic in style, depicting all aspects of nature, landscapes and cityscapes, some portraits and many, many flowers. Recently, she has been experimenting with miniatures using some new techniques. “I love colors, but I love the old Japanese art too. I am trying now to reduce my intense colors and make my work more subdued.”
